## ORDER OF ARREST

On this date the Court was made aware that the above-named defendant violated the conditions of his community supervision as follows:

- Defendant failed to comply with condition that states, have no contact with persons 17 years of age or 1. younger, unless contact is ordered by the court, to-wit: during polygraph conducted on September 23, 2024, defendant admitted to Polygraph Examiner, Ronald Russell, that he visited his employer's residence and stated that his two nephews, ages 4 and 7 were both present.
- Defendant failed to comply with condition that states, not go in, or within a distance of 1,000 feet of, 2. premises where children commonly gather, including a school, day care facility, playground, public or private youth center, public swimming pool, or video arcade facility, to-wit: during polygraph conducted on September 23, 2024, defendant admitted to Polygraph Examiner, Ronald Russell, that he hat at Chick Fil A with his mother one time.
- Defendant failed to comply with condition "not go in, or within a distance of 1,000 feet of, premises 3. where children commonly gather, including a school, day care facility, playground, public or private youth center, public swimming pool, or video arcade facility to-wit" during polygraph conducted on September 23, 2024, defendant admitted to Polygraph Examiner, Ronald Russell, that he picked up food that's near a child safety zone.

It is THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to Article 42a.751 (Sec. b) Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, that a capias issue for the Defendant's arrest and/or that the Defendant be committed to the Montgomery County Law Enforcement Center immediately to await the further orders of the Court.
